
















WELCOME to MANRRS <u>NEW</u> Virtual National Conference Experience







Attendee Information Questions


- Job Title and Background (Professionals Only):
 - Provide your Job title and area of study/expertise.
- Organization:
 - Spell out complete company name. No acronyms.
- Mailing Address:
 - Provide physical address to permanent home address or where you are currently residing.

Registration Questions

- Resume Upload (required):
 - Student participants are required to upload a resume to participate in the conference. Acceptable file formats are .doc/.docx/.pdf. If you do not have a resume, you are encouraged to use the sample template provided. Please ask an Advisor or Career Services to review final resume prior to uploading.
 - This is optional for Professionals.
- Personal/Alternative Email:
 - Provide personal alternative to work or school.
- Contest Judge (Professionals Only):
 - Select Yes and the contest if you would like to serve as a contest judge.







Impact/Engagement Questions

- Leadership Role:
 - List any current involvement on the local or national level with MANRRS (i.e. Chapter Officer, Committee Member, etc.)
- Summer Internship:
 - Provide whether or not you have a planned or cancelled internship for Summer 2020/2021. If yes, provide the company you interned with. Spell out the company's full name.
- Alumni Member:
 - If you are an Undergraduate Student, select No to this question.
 - For Graduates and Professionals, select Yes if you participated in MANRRS as an Undergraduate Student Member
