Section I: Applicant Requirements

Application Opens: December 1, 2023 **Application Closes:** February 1, 2024

All applicants are required to do the following:

- Must have been a collegiate MANRRS member for at least 1 academic year.
- Record a short up to 3-minute video telling why you desire to serve as a National Officer and how you can contribute to the transformation of the National Society. Upload via preferred platform and provide the URL.
- Complete a phone interview where you will be contacted upon full completion.
- <u>Undergraduate students</u> applying for Officer Positions must submit <u>two letters of recommendation</u>: one from your MANRRS advisor and one from a collegiate professor or current/past employer.
- <u>Graduate students</u> applying for Officer Positions must submit <u>two letters of recommendation</u>: one from your MANRRS advisor and one from your department chair or graduate advisor.
- Submit a Current Resume/CV
- Submit an Unofficial Transcript
- Must be available for the MANRRS event dates:
 - o National Officer Training and Development Training: May 2024
 - o National Officer Training and Leadership Development Summer Meeting: July 2024
 - o National Officer Training and Leadership Development Winter Meeting: January 2025
 - o National MANRRS 39th Annual Training Conference and Career Expo April 2-6, 2025
