# **Section I: Applicant Requirements**

## All Applicants Must Complete the Following Requirements

- Must have been an active collegiate MANRRS member for a minimum of one (1) academic year.
- Record a video (up to 3 minutes) expressing your interest in serving as a National Officer and how you plan to contribute to the transformation of the National Society. Upload via your preferred platform and include the URL in your application.
- Undergraduate applicants must submit two letters of recommendation: one from their MANRRS advisor and one from a collegiate professor or current/past employer
- Graduate applicants must submit two letters of recommendation: one from their MANRRS advisor and one from their department chair or graduate advisor
- Attend one (1) interest meeting session prior to the application deadline
- Submit a current résumé or curriculum vitae (CV)
- Submit an unofficial academic transcript (GPA Requirement is 2.8 for all officer roles)
- Must be available for the MANRRS event dates:
  - o National Officer Training and Development Training: May 17-20, 2026
  - o National Officer Training and Leadership Development Summer Meeting: July 22-26, 2026
  - o National Officer Training and Leadership Development Winter Meeting: January 2027
  - o National Annual Training Conference and Career Expo: March 30 April 3, 2027 (San Diego, California)

## **Section III: Letter of Recommendation**

### **Advisor Recommendation Letter Guidelines**

The recommendation letter should:

- Confirm the candidate's current GPA, requirement is 2.8
- Specify the length of their MANRRS membership
- Provide a thoughtful explanation of why the candidate is being recommended for an Executive Committee role, highlighting their leadership potential, contributions to the organization, and alignment with MANRRS values
