



National MANRRS Professional Officer Candidate Application

The purpose of this application is to provide the nominating committee with information on each nominee and to provide the opportunity for each nominee to express his or her desire and commitment to serve the National MANRRS Organization as a Professional Officer. In addition, the information is collected to facilitate the conference activities associated with the National MANRRS officer selection process.

Minimal Requirements:

- Hold a completed B.S. degree with a minimum of eight (8) years in a leadership role, or a completed M.S. degree with at least four (4) years in a leadership role
 - Nominee must demonstrate leadership experience across professional and personal spheres, including service to the National Society as a committee member, national officer, advisor, or representative of a partner organization
- Nominees must be active members in good standing and must maintain this status throughout their service term on the Executive Committee..
- Complete a background check, as the role involves engagement with vulnerable audiences.
- Complete a screening interview following the submission of nomination materials.
- Attend one (1) interest meeting session prior to the application deadline.

CONFERENCE REMINDERS

Candidates will participate in the final nomination process during the 40th Annual Training Conference and Career Expo in Dallas, Texas. Attendance at the conference is mandatory for all slated nominees.

ONCE ELECTED

The newly elected officer should plan to connect with the current Executive Committee for a brief orientation. In addition, newly elected officers must attend:

- National Officer Training and Development Orientation: May 17-20, 2026
- National Officer Training and Leadership Development Program Summer Meeting: July 22-26, 2026
- National Officer Training and Leadership Development Program Winter Meeting: January 2027
- National MANRRS 41st Annual Training Conference and Career Expo: March 30- April 3, 2027 in San Diego, California

The candidate should plan to attend multiple teleconferences set at the cadence of the National President and several other activities throughout the year as well. MANRRS will cover travel-related expenses to approved events.
