Location: Vernal, UT – BLM Vernal Field Office

Job Title: Geospatial Information Specialist, GS 0301

Related Degree: Geographic Information Systems, Geography, Recreation Planning

Position Description:

The BLM Vernal Field Office does not have a process in place for inventorying and maintaining all of the signs they have installed out on the landscape. The end goal is to have a GIS database that will be used on tablets out in the field to record every sign out on the landscape. This database will have the capability to document proposed and damaged signs. The data collected in the field will be uploaded to an online database that can be accessed by the field office sign coordinator who will then come up with a phased plan of sign installation and repair. The data collection process is in place, but the data collection in the field has not been completed. Our team is looking for one intern to complete data collection for all, current signs within the field office .

The BLM Vernal Field Office has a proposed campground, three proposed trailheads, and 55 miles of proposed non-motorized trails, totaling 960 acres. These proposals all need class III cultural surveys completed in order to determine their viability. Due to only having two Archaeological Technicians on our Table of Organization that have been identified to prioritize workloads that do not include the aforementioned surveys, our team is looking for two interns that can complete the surveys required for the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process.
