



## USDA Forest Service Resource Assistant Program

**Position.** North Zone Trails

**Duration.** 8 Month Fellowship (32 weeks): Starting June 2023 – February 2024

**Location.** North Fork Ranger District. 11 Casey Road. North Fork, Idaho. 83466

**Reports To.** The North Zone Trails position will report to the North Zone Recreation Management Specialist.

### Job Overview

This position will fill a key role in the North Zone recreation program. The position will report to the North Zone trails lead and will assist in providing leadership to a temporary workforce and partnership organizations. Duties include but are not limited to: conducting routine trail maintenance on 782 miles of non-Wilderness trails, assisting and overseeing large projects with other FS personnel and partner groups, inventorying and maintaining a trails tool cache, assisting in developing a wheeled non-motorized trails program, conducting TRACS surveys, and inventorying and monitoring trail conditions. At the GS-07 level, the position will also assist in project planning and volunteer outreach.

### Responsibilities and Duties

- Support the North Zone Trails Program
- Support Partner Organizations.
- Inventory and Maintain Trails.
- Assist in Project Planning and Volunteer Outreach.

### Qualifications

- Interest in Public Lands Trails Management
- Ability to Work as a Member of a Team in Remote Locations.

### Minimum Requirements

- Completion of 2 years at an accredited university, an Associate's degree, or higher
- US citizenship or permanent residency. RAs must undergo a government background check if selected.
- Participation in US Forest Service Orientation Training scheduled for June 2023
