The form is structured based on the guidelines stated within the current constitution and bylaws. Each proposed amendment must be co-signed by at least two (2) members in good standing. Each proposed amendment will require this form to be completed.

Any amendment should be received by the National Secretary:

- by September 19, 2025, at 11:59 PM (Eastern) for the Fall State of Society. The form should be submitted through the on-line submission portal.
- at least 30 days before the annual business meeting. For MANRRS40, amendments must be submitted by March 11, 2026, at 11:59 PM (Eastern). The form should be submitted through the on-line submission portal.

Failure to complete this form in its entirety shall result in the immediate rejection of the submission.
